



SELF-DECLARATION concerning the FSC- POL-01-004 (Policy for the association of organizations with the FSC®)

The organization that subscribes to this statement explicitly agreeing now and in the future, as long as the relationship with the FSC® exists, does not participate directly or indirectly in the following inadmissible activities:

- a) Illegal logging or trade of wood or illegal forest products;
- b) Violation of traditional and human rights in forestry operations;
- c) Destruction of high conservation values in forestry operations;
- d) Significant conversion of forests to plantations or non-forest uses;
- e) Introduction of genetically modified organisms in silvicultural operations;
- f) Violation of any of the fundamental ILO conventions as defined in the ILO declaration on fundamental principles and rights at work.

In turn, the organization is committed to meeting each and every one of the FSC® core work requirements throughout its operations, including the following as basic principles:

- To work at all times taking into account the rights and obligations established by national laws
- Not to employ workers under the minimum age stipulated in national or local laws or regulations, taking into account the additional points of compliance in particular cases in relation to regions allowing the employment of persons aged between 13 and 15, hazardous work and the prohibition of the worst forms of child labor
- Prohibit all forms of forced or compulsory labour, including the additional points and clauses described in point 7 of the standard to be met
- Ensure that there is no discrimination related to the occupation of jobs or the freedom of workers as regards their labour and bargaining rights
